The meaning behind this verse has been driving our decisions on what's best for the kids at Trinity Academy. Our hope is that each one of our students will leave our school after 8th grade equipped with the knowledge, skills, and confidence needed to defend their faith, and live a life that seeks to achieve harmony.

The 2022-23 school year marked Mrs. Johnson's last year as the building Principal and Director of Ministry after 17 years of service. She poured her heart and soul into the Academy and the greater Trinity community; as a result we are stronger than ever. I have come to find the truth in her claims of how great our school is and our students' academic achievements highlighted here offer more proof. As a staff we are identifying areas that we can improve on; one of which is to build our capacity to support our learners through improving our Student Support Teams (SST) composition. We have made huge strides in this process and the new collaborative approach is already making a difference in the lives of our kids. We are embracing the fact that not all kids learn the same and understand it is our mission to meet kids where they are at, and take them to places they didn't think they could go. We had 206 students enrolled in the Academy in the 2022-23 school year, and we currently have 211 students enrolled for the 2023-24 school year. It has been a revolving door of tours and inquiries; we couldn't be happier with the buzz in our community and the greater St. Croix area about our small but mighty school. We formed a committee at the beginning of the school year whose mission is to explore potential options for growing our school. We are keeping our faith in God's plan and are confident that he will shed light on the path that is right for Trinity Academy.

STUDENT ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT:

The 3 graphs presented are the results of our Fall 2023 IOWA Basics assessments. 77.8 % of our students in grades 1-2 are scoring at or above the 50% nationwide on the core composite. 79.7% of our 3rd-5th are scoring at or above the 50% on the complete composite and 61.6% 6th-8th are scoring at or above the 50% on the complete composite. The complete composite includes all core subjects: reading, written expression, conventions of writing, vocabulary, mathematics, computation along with social studies and science. Standardized assessments are just a snapshot of a child's academic performance and one of the multitudes of assessments we use to measure academic achievement and growth in our students.

<u>National Jr. Honor Society:</u> 11 Trinity students/members. This fall 10 new members were inducted. Advisors Mr. Malsack and Mrs. Straka ensure that all of the students uphold the values of Service, Leadership, Scholarship and Character.




- 4 Students achieved Highest Honors of 4.0 GPA or above

- 13 Students achieved Honors of a 3.0-3.66 GPA



We've had many esthetic changes to our school this year! Last spring, thanks to a


generous/anonymous donation, our parking lot was given a much needed update with new seal coating and striping.
